YOUR HEALTH

There is a myth that abortion is better for women than childbirth. But the evidence in the published medical literature shows the opposite to be true.

Compared with giving birth, women who abort are at higher risk of preterm birth, mental health problems, and in the case of aborting a first pregnancy, an increased risk of breast cancer.

The Facts:

- One abortion increases a woman's risk of preterm birth by 30%. Two
- or more abortions increases a woman's risk of **preterm birth** by 50-70%.
- Overall, women with an abortion history experience an 81%
- increased risk for mental health problems.
 - Ending a pregnancy before 32 weeks, either by miscarriage,
- preterm birth or induced abortion increases a woman's risk of breast cancer.
- A single induced abortion increases the risk of maternal death by 45% compared to women with no history of abortion.


