## This seminar will:

- o Deepen understanding of Hippocratic ethical principles in contrast to the prevailing utilitarian and autonomy-only ethics.
- o Explore the medical, social, ethical, and legal aspects surrounding abortion and physician-assisted suicide.
- o Review conscience protections for healthcare professionals and teach basic advocacy skills.
- o Incorporate group discussions, case presentations, and mentorship to facilitate advocacy for Hippocratic Medicine.
- o Understand legal obligations to conscience protections in medical schools, residencies, and medical practices.

## Seminar Outline

This seminar includes approximately 2 hours of online learning per week for 12 weeks. Learning modalities include pre-recorded lectures and weekly video discussions on a flipped-classroom teaching model. There will be optional learning material for those wishing to explore various topics more thoroughly as well as for building a future library of resources.

There are no papers or assignments, but it is expected that learners will review all learning material prior to each live session in order to benefit most from the group discussion and mentorship.

There will be opportunities for practicing testimonies and resolution writing as well as networking with other students and mentors. An internal **Certificate of Completion** will be offered by the sponsoring organizations: Med/Law Students for Life of America and the American Association of ProLife OBGYNs (AAPLOG). There will also be a Hippocratic Oath ceremony at the end of the course. **Visit the site below for registration dates.**
